

Hida Takayama & Shirakawa-go Alpine Adventure with Panorama Ginza Ridge Trek – 7 Days ATS-006





Embark on an extraordinary alpine adventure that combines Japan's most iconic mountain village heritage with one of the country's most spectacular high-altitude ridge walks. This journey takes you from the historic streets of Hida Takayama through the UNESCO World

Heritage site of Shirakawa-go, then deep into the Northern Japan Alps for the legendary Panorama Ginza traverse.

Experience the pristine wilderness of Kamikochi, Japan's premier alpine resort, before ascending to the legendary Panorama Ginza – a breathtaking ridge walk connecting some of Japan's most magnificent peaks including Chogatake, Jonen-dake, and Tsubakuro-dake. This high-altitude traverse offers unparalleled panoramic views across the Japan Alps, earning its nickname "Ginza" (Silver Seat) for being the crown jewel of Japanese alpine hiking.

Stay in traditional mountain huts perched dramatically on ridge lines at over 2,600 meters elevation, where you'll witness spectacular sunrises and sunsets painting the surrounding peaks in golden alpenglow. The journey concludes in historic Matsumoto, home to one of Japan's most beautiful original castles, providing the perfect cultural finale to your mountain adventure.


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Altitude Unit:

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Your alpine adventure begins in Hida Takayama, a beautifully preserved Edo-period town nestled in the Northern Japan Alps. This historic merchant town, with its traditional ryokan inns and sake breweries, serves as the perfect launching point for your mountain journey. After settling into your accommodation, enjoy a welcome dinner featuring the region's local specialties.

Accommodation: Hotel Wood Takayama - A comfortable base in the heart of this historic alpine town.

Day 02 : Shirakawa-go Heritage & Kamikochi Alpine Gateway

Journey to the UNESCO World Heritage site of Shirakawa-go, famous for its traditional gassho-zukuri farmhouses with steep thatched roofs designed to withstand heavy snowfall. From the observation deck, capture stunning views of this living museum village set against mountain backdrops. Continue to Kamikochi, Japan's most celebrated alpine resort at 1,500m elevation, where crystal-clear rivers flow through pristine valleys surrounded by towering peaks. Walk along the famous Azusa River to either Myojin or Tokusawa, traditional mountain lodges that have welcomed alpine enthusiasts for generations.

Accommodation: Myojin-kan or Tokusawa-en – Historic mountain lodges in the heart of Kamikochi's pristine wilderness.

- * Continue to Hirayu Bus Terminal

Day 03 : Ascent to the Panorama Ginza - Chogatake

Begin your legendary Panorama Ginza traverse with an early start from the valley floor. The trail ascends through ancient forests before emerging above treeline onto alpine meadows. As you climb higher, the views become increasingly spectacular, with the Hodaka peaks and Yarigatake spear dominating the horizon. Reach Chogatake Hut (2,677m), perched dramatically on the ridge with commanding 360-degree views. This is where the famous "Panorama Ginza" begins – a high-altitude ridge walk considered one of Japan's most beautiful mountain experiences.

Accommodation: Chogatake Hut – A mountain refuge offering spectacular alpine sunrise and sunset views from 2,677m elevation.

- * Early breakfast at mountain lodge
- * Begin ascent to Chogatake (600 min including breaks)
- * Arrive at Chogatake Hut

Day 04: Panorama Ginza Ridge Walk to Jonen-dake

Experience the crown jewel of Japanese alpine hiking along the Panorama Ginza ridge. This spectacular high-altitude traverse offers continuous panoramic views across the Japan Alps, with the trail following knife-edge ridges and gentle alpine slopes. The route to Jonen-dake provides some of the most photographed mountain scenery in Japan, with views stretching from the Hodaka peaks to distant Mount Fuji on clear days. The constant elevation above 2,500m offers an exhilarating sense of being on top of the world.

Accommodation: Jonen Hut - Located at 2,524m with stunning views of the surrounding alpine landscape.

- * Mountain hut breakfast
- * Ridge walk along Panorama Ginza (540 min)
- * Arrive at Jonen Hut

Day 05: Final Summit & Descent to Civilization

Complete your Panorama Ginza traverse with a visit to Otensho before the final stretch to Tsubakuro-dake area and Enzanso Hut. From here, enjoy your last mountain sunrise before beginning the descent back to the valley. The contrast between the high alpine world you've inhabited and the return to lower elevations provides a poignant conclusion to your ridge walk adventure.

Accommodation: Enzanso Hut – Your final mountain hut experience with panoramic alpine views.

- * Mountain hut breakfast
- * Continue ridge traverse to Otensho
- * Lunch break at Otensho
- * Final stretch to Enzanso
- * Arrive at Enzanso Hut

Day 06 : Return to Valley & Matsumoto Castle Town

Descend from your mountain world back to the valley floor, completing your alpine circuit at Nakabusa Onsen trailhead. After days in the high mountains, relax in natural hot springs before transferring to historic Matsumoto. This castle town, dominated by one of Japan's most beautiful original castles, provides the perfect cultural conclusion to your mountain adventure. Celebrate your achievement with a farewell dinner featuring local Shinshu cuisine and sake.

Accommodation: Onyado Nono Matsumoto or Hotel Kagetsu – Comfortable accommodations in historic Matsumoto.

- * Final mountain breakfast
- * Descent to Nakabusa Onsen trailhead
- * Arrive at trailhead
- * Hot spring bath and lunch at Ariakeso
- * Transfer to Matsumoto by chartered bus
- * Check-in at hotel
- * Farewell dinner at Wa-dining Kurasuwa

Accommodation: Onyado Nono Matsumoto or Hotel Kagetsu





Conclude your alpine adventure with a visit to Matsumoto Castle, one of Japan's twelve original castles and a designated National Treasure. This "Crow Castle," with its distinctive black exterior, represents the perfect blend of defensive architecture and aesthetic beauty. After exploring the castle grounds and learning about samurai history, gather for final group photos before departing with memories of an unforgettable journey through Japan's alpine heartland.
